Back to School Supply List

Updated June 2019

**All STMS students need a backpack or book bag to bring materials back and forth to school.*

Sixth Grade:

In backpack

- 3-4 Pencils
 - o Lead, if using mechanical pencils
- 3-4 Pencil top erasers
- Lined paper (to keep in classroom, not backpack)
- 1 - Large eraser
- 4 – Lined composition books
- 4 – Highlighters
- 2 – Ultra-fine point Sharpies (permanent marker)
- 1 – pack of colored pencils
- 1 – pair earbuds/headphones
- 1 – novel for silent reading
- 1 – 8 ½ x 11 Spiral quad ruled notebook with integrated pocket folder. “Stellar” or “Mead” brands are preferred, but not required.
- 6 – pocket folders (aka Pee-Chees) 1 for each class, labelled
- 2 – single subject notebook (for science)
- 2 – dry erase markers
- *(Special Education Math only) – 1 – 3” three ring binder

In reserve at home

- Pencils (extra supply)
- Pencil top erasers (extra supply)
- back up large eraser
- King County Library Card (optional)

Note: calculators are not required for 6th grade math. Also, please no binders*. We will use the PeeChee folders in place of them. Parents may want to purchase another 6 PeeChee folders for second semester (January).

Seventh Grade:

In backpack

- 1 – Three ring binder with dividers or accordion folder
- 2 – pocket folders (aka Pee-Chees)
- 1 – Pencil pouch
- 3-4 Pencils
 - o Lead, if using mechanical pencils
- 1 – Eraser
- 5 – Lined composition books
- 2 – Sharpies (permanent marker)
 - o 1 ultra-fine, 1 regular
- 1 pack – Highlighters, such as Sharpie Gel
- 1 pack – colored pencils
- 1 pair – Earbuds/headphones
- 1 box – Kleenex/tissue to STRETCH teacher

- 1 pack – Colored pencils or pens
- 3-4 – Pens (black or blue)
- 1 pack – Highlighters
- 4 – Lined composition books (or spiral notebooks)
- Glue stick or tape for attaching content in comp books
- 1 – Graph paper spiral/composition
- 1 – Ruler
- 1 – Pair scissors
- 1 pair – Earbuds/headphones
- 1 - novel for silent reading
- (Optional) Sharpies
