

Starting tomorrow, December 2nd, we start our WIN Wednesday format. It was created from an interest to provide specific time and structure for extra help and support for students and teachers. It would allow for struggling student opportunities to get more feedback on how to close the gap between present and desired performance. Finally, it would provide more opportunities for high interest or "fun things" for kids during this remote experience.

This was not easy task. We greatly appreciate the students, families, and staff who completed surveys in October, met and collaborated with school personnel in meetings in late Oct. and early Nov., and to the STMS and TSD staff who worked together on the last Wednesdays to create these sessions for our kids.
